Inter-Branch Competition Classes

All models entered must be by BMSS members

Class 1: Groups of figures, 5 to 20 toy soldiers.

Class 2: Flat Figures.

Class 3: Single foot figure up to and

including 30mm.

Class 4: Single foot figure from 31 up to

54mm.

Class 5: Single Foot figure larger than

54mm.

Class 6: Single mounted figure between

31 and 54mm.

Class 7: Single mounted figure larger

than 54mm "standard".

Class 8: Busts.

Class 9: Converted and scratchbuilt.

Class 10: Artillery pieces with or without

crew

Class 11: Single AFV or softskin in 1/72 or

1/76 scales. Crew may be

included.

Class 12: Larger than 1/72 or 1/76 scale

single AFV or softskin. Crew may

be included.

Class 13: Vignette. Two or three figures on

a common theme, on a common

base.

Class 14; Open or closed dioramas.

Class 15: Junior (aged 16 or below) figures

and vehicles.

Class 16: Non-military entries (no erotica).

Individual Classes for BMSS members

Class 1: Peter Wilcox Trophy: Ancients and mediaeval single figures up to 1485 AD.

Class 2: Blytheswood Trophy: Flat figures, single groups or dioramas. Semi flat figures are not eligible for this class.

Class 3: Britains Trophy. For Britains figures.

Class 4: The Editor's Trophy: For humorous entries.

Class 5: The Fosten Guards Trophy: For figures of any Guards regiment of any nation.

Class 6: The micro-scale Clegg award: For figures up to 30mm.

Class 7: The Napoleonic Trophy: For single figures and vignettes (2 or 3 figures) of any nation involved in the Revolutionary and Napoleonic Wars 1792-1815.

Class 8: The John Peck Trophy: For Bands and Corps of Drums.

Class 9: The Wendy Dilley Award: For single figures of female warriors and ancillaries.

Class
10: The Gottstein Trophy: The novices' class single figures of any type. Entrants must not previously have

won a BMSS National Competition.

Footnote 1: In the event of any doubt on the day, we will advise and allocate models to models most appropriate class.

Footnote 2: "Mounted" means accompanied by an appropriate animal. This includes fully mounted, mounting or dismounting, standing by a mount, or taking cover behind a dead mount.

Footnote 3: Any additional information you provide, regarding extra work done, is always helpful to the judges, especially in relation to scratchbuilt/converted models.

Footnote 4: If any questions are raised regarding the competitions or the judging of any classes, after consultation, the Chief Judge's decision is final.
